I have reviewed your Right to Know Law ("RTKL") Request that was forwarded to the Cumberland County District Attorney's Office by the Office of Open Records on November 22, 2019, under P.S. § 67.101, et seq. I concur with the New Cumberland Borough Police Department finding that incident report you seek is exempt from disclosure under RTKL. 65 P.S. § 67.708(b)(16), 65 P.S. § 67.708(b)(17).

Specifically, this incident report is a record that was generated through a criminal investigation and includes investigative materials, notes, and reports. In addition, it is my understanding that the investigation is still on going. As such, disclosure of this report could jeopardize the investigation by revealing progress of police or impairing law enforcement's ability to locate or detain a defendant when identified.

I understand this must be frustrating and that you are requesting the information for insurance purposes. Please be patient, as the information may become available to you once the investigation is complete.

You may file an appeal of this decision to the Cumberland County Court of Common Pleas. 65 Pa. Con. Stat. § 67.1302(a); Pennsylvanians for Union Reform v. Ctr. Cnty. DA's Office, 139 A.3d 354 (Pa. Cmwlth. 2016).
