Dear Michael:


The Office of Open Records (“OOR”) received your request for an advisory opinion on May 24, 2023. The OOR may issue advisory opinions pursuant to Section 1310 of the Right-to-Know Law (“RTKL”), 65 P.S. § 67.1310(a)(2). Your request for an advisory opinion is respectfully **DENIED**.

In your advisory opinion request, you note that the request is related to a currently pending appeal docketed at OOR Dkt. AP 2023-1083. Because of that fact, you should address any issues or concerns in that case to the assigned appeals officer, as an advisory opinion would not be proper at this time.

Due to the nature of your questions, you may wish to review 18 Pa.C.S. § 4911 (Tampering with public records or information). Any alleged violations of that section would be a criminal matter, so concerns or questions about an alleged violation should be directed to law enforcement.
