Re: Right to Know Law Request Appeal

Dear Mr. Silverlight,

I have reviewed your Right to Know Law ("RTKL") Request that was forwarded to the Cumberland County District Attorney's Office, under P.S. § 67.101, et seq. I concur with the Upper Allen Police Department's finding that police report you seek is exempt from disclosure under RTKL. 65 P.S. § 67.708(b)(16), 65 P.S. § 67.708(b)(17).

Specifically, this incident report is a record that was generated through a criminal investigation and includes investigative materials, notes, and reports. In addition, it is my understanding that the investigation is still on going. As such, disclosure of this report could jeopardize the investigation by revealing progress of police or impairing law enforcement's ability to locate or detain a defendant when identified.

I understand this must be frustrating. Please be patient, as the information may become available to you once the investigation is complete.

You may file an appeal of this decision to the Cumberland County Court of Common Pleas. 65 Pa. Con. Stat. § 67.1302(a); *Pennsylvanians for Union Reform v. Ctr. Cnty. DA's Office*, 139 A.3d 354 (Pa. Cmwlth. 2016).
